

DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS

The School Board shall delegate to the superintendent the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools will be operated.

Such rules and detailed arrangements shall constitute the administrative rules governing the schools. They must be in every respect consistent with the policies adopted by the School Board.

The School Board itself shall formulate and adopt administrative regulations only when required by law, and when the superintendent recommends School Board adoption in light of strong community attitudes or probable staff reaction.
