

SUPPORT SERVICES GOALS/PRIORITY OBJECTIVES

The MSAD #68 School Board recognizes that the support services of the school system are essential to the primary function of the school system, which is education. To fulfill this secondary but important function, the School Board will:

- A. Ensure the proper operation and maintenance of school buildings, vehicles, equipment, and services; set high standards of safety; promote the health of students and staff; reflect the aspirations of the community; and support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide good instruction;
- B. Encourage the establishment of efficient and businesslike procedures for the management of buildings and grounds, offices, vehicles, equipment, supplies, and the food program;
- C. Encourage the establishment of a thorough, effective, and economical maintenance program, including preventive maintenance, that will ensure a maximum useful life of school property, vehicles, buildings, and equipment; and
- D. Encourage the adherence to generally accepted management principles and applicable laws and regulations when establishing policies and regulations in these areas.
