

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS SECURITY

School buildings constitute one of the greatest investments of the community. In the interest of preserving the safety and welfare of students and of protecting this investment to the extent possible, the Superintendent may develop regulations and procedures that will:

- A. Ensure the security of school property, as appropriate;
- B. Minimize fire hazards;
- C. Reduce the possibility of faulty equipment;
- D. Provide for the keeping of records and funds in a safe place;
- E. Protect against vandalism and burglary; and
- F. Provide for the prosecution of vandals.
