

**STUDENT POSSESSION AND PERSONAL USE OF
WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES**

It is the policy of the MSAD 68 Board of Directors that any student who wishes to use a personal wireless communication device in school and during the school day must obtain the written permission of the Principal. Such use is viewed as a privilege and not a right and permission will be granted only if the parent or guardian establishes, to the satisfaction of the Principal, that a reasonable basis exists for the possession and personal use of the device.

The MSAD 68 Board defines wireless communication devices as those that have the ability to send and receive information utilizing radio frequencies such as cell phones, pagers, personal data assistants (PDA), laptop computers with cellular/phone capability, two-way radios, and walkie-talkies.
