

## STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

In general, the School Board approves of fundraising in the community by students for school activities. The School Board also recognizes that classes and clubs may wish to raise money through fund-raising drives. Fund-raising events shall be reviewed and approved by the Principal. In questionable areas, the Principal shall refer the request to the Superintendent.

Examples of acceptable fund-raising activities:

Magazine drives; sales of tickets or advertising space in publications; math-a-thon; bottle drives; popcorn and craft sales as well as charitable purposes to benefit DARE, etc.
