

## EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS

The Board recognizes that Maine statutes restrict the work hours for students enrolled in school who are under age 16, and, to a lesser extent, for students who are 16 and 17. The law authorizes the Superintendent/designee to issue work permits to minors under 16 under certain conditions, including that he/she be enrolled in school, not truant, not under suspension and currently passing a majority of courses. Permits may be revoked by the Superintendent if these conditions are not maintained.
